Onorato Celebrates Expansion of Global Company in Duquesne

In September 2006, Allegheny County Executive Dan Onorato and Pennsylvania Community & Economic Development Secretary Dennis Yablonsky joined local officials to celebrate the expansion of American Textile Company in the Mon Valley. The company built an additional 83,000-square-foot facility adjacent to its headquarters in RIDC Park in Duquesne to expand its pillow manufacturing line, which will create up to 50 new jobs.

American Textile Company was founded by five brothers in 1925 to manufacture mattress covers for Sears, Roebuck and Co. Today, the company remains in the Ruttenberg family and produces a number of allergen barrier products for most major retailers in the United States and Canada. American Textile's headquarters and distribution center are located in Duquesne.
